NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS SCHEDULES MEETING FOR APRIL 4 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards has scheduled a meeting of its subcommittee on planning and procedures on April 4 in Rockville, Maryland.
