NRC STAFF ASSIGNS NEW RESIDENT INSPECTOR TO SUSQUEHANNA

Alan J. Blamey has been selected as the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's new resident inspector at the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station in Berwick, Pa. He joins Senior Resident Inspector Ken Jenison and Resident Inspector John Richmond at the dual-reactor site.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear plant has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring major work projects and interfacing with plant workers and the public.

Mr. Blamey joined the NRC in September 1997 as a reactor engineer in the Region I Division of Reactor Projects in King of Prussia, Pa. He was assigned to Susquehanna on July 5.

Prior to joining the NRC, Mr. Blamey worked for 13 years at Commonwealth Edison's Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station. He held various positions in the engineering and operations departments and was a licensed senior reactor operator.

Mr. Blamey received a Bachelor of Science degree in nuclear engineering from The Pennsylvania State University. He was recognized by the Philadelphia Federal Executive Board as federal employee "Rookie of the Year 1998". Mr. Blamey and his wife live in Drums, Pa.
