Dear Mr. Fletcher:

We have reviewed the Maryland license conditions that were submitted to meet the Generally Licenced Device (GL) reporting requirements of 10 CFR 32.52 (a) and (b). Our review and comments are in response to the State's request for Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) evaluation of the license conditions that incorporated the amendment identified on the States Regulation Status Data Sheet (SRS). These license conditions were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC rules in 10 CFR 32.52 and the requirements of the one amendment identified in the enclosed SRS. We discussed our review of the license conditions with Ray Manley on March 3, 2004.

As a result of our review, we have no comments, however we would like to ensure that it is understood that the remaining portion of the GL Rule was due for Agreement State adoption on February 16, 2004. Please note that we have limited our review to the items required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that the Maryland license conditions, as adopted, meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Maryland regulations and/or legally binding requirements, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
