We have reviewed Supplement 11 to the Maryland Radiological Health Program Rules (COMAR 26.12.01.01 "Regulations for the Control of Ionizing Radiation", effective June 7, 2004) received by our office on March 24, 2005. In addition, we reviewed our letter to you dated August 13, 2003, which contains our comments on your proposed version of these rules. These final regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations in 10 CFR Part 20, 34, 35, 36 and 39 and the requirements of five amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the final regulations with Raymond Manley, on May 11, 2005.

As a result of our review, we have no comments. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that the regulations, as adopted, meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Maryland regulations, as indicated.
