## **NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET MARCH 6-8 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.**

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting March 6-8 in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, topics of interest to NRC Commissioner Peter Lyons. In addition, the Committee will discuss the staff's final safety evaluation report for review of the license renewal applications for both the James A. FitzPatrick and the Vermont Yankee nuclear power stations.

Portions of this meeting, identified in the agenda, may be closed to protect proprietary information.

The ACRS advises the Commission on licensing and operation of nuclear power plants and related safety issues.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike.
