NRC MEETING NOV. 16 IN ROCKVILLE, MD., TO DISCUSS NEW REACTOR CONSTRUCTION ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will host a panel discussion in Rockville, Md., on Monday, Nov. 16, to discuss the agency's process for assessing licensee performance during new reactor construction efforts.

The NRC will hold the meeting from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. in the Bethesda North Marriott Hotel and Conference Center, 5701 Marinelli Road in Rockville. Senior NRC managers, along with representatives from the nuclear industry and state government, will discuss the development of the agency's construction assessment process. The group will also examine the Reactor Oversight Process (ROP) used for operating nuclear power plants and discuss how portions of the ROP's assessment process could be included in construction assessment.

The public is invited to participate in the meeting, which will include a moderated question-and-answer session. A teleconference line will be available for members of the public.
