NRC CHAIRMAN GREGORY B. JACZKO'S REMARKS ABOUT BRIEFING ON AGENCY EEO, DIVERSITY AND SMALL BUSINESS PROGRAMS

Note: The NRC Commissioners were briefed today by NRC staff on the status of the agency's equal employment opportunity (EEO), diversity management and small business programs.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has been awarded The Best Place to Work in the federal government for the second consecutive timer and recognized recently in *The Washingtonian* magazine as a Great Place to Work. Furthermore, our latest Internal Safety Culture survey results showed our staff's high level of engagement and job satisfaction. In addition, we were again named Best Diversity Company, a Top Supporter of Historically Black Colleges and Universities, and received a green scorecard for our small business accomplishments.

The agency has much to be proud of and we are obviously doing great work here. Our staff deserves thanks for its hard work and dedication for achieving these accomplishments.

Today, at this semi-annual briefing, we discussed how we can make further improvements in these programs so that we can continue our progress in the EEO, diversity and small business programs.
