

Telecon Summary on Environmental Request For Additional Information Responses

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) contractors requested clarification regarding the tables included in the response to Request for Additional Information (RAI 8). The tables need to address both pre-construction and construction. The column labeling will also be clarified. Although International Isotopes Inc., (INIS) is not certain they will need to do preconstruction, they should consider including it in the Environmental Report in case it becomes necessary.

NRC staff requested clarification on the model INIS used in developing air emission power factors. INIS used the NONROAD methodology to calculate their site specific data. The applicant will provide examples of the calculations to NRC staff to illustrate the modeling approach.

Table 4-1 appears to have discrepancies between the draft RAI response and the final RAI response. INIS will review the two submittals and provide an update.

NRC staff requested clarification as to whether Low Level Waste will be generated during construction. INIS indicated that materials purchased from the former Sequoya Fuels facility may have limited contamination which will need to be cleaned and disposed of during construction.
