## NRC SCHEDULES PUBLIC MEETING JUNE 21 TO DISCUSS IMPLEMENTING REVISIONS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION REGULATIONS RULE FOR LICENSE RENEWAL OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled a meeting for Tuesday, June 21, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., to discuss the implementation of a final rule revising the environmental protection regulations for the renewal of nuclear power plant operating licenses and other environmental review issues.

NRC staff will begin the meeting with a presentation on implementing the rule. Then industry will provide a presentation followed by an opportunity for open discussion. The public is invited to participate in this meeting.

The meeting will be held at the NRC Headquarters, 11555 Rockville Pike, room O13G04. A complete agenda is available on the NRC's public meeting schedule Web page.
