NRC STAFF TO MEET WITH OMAHA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS FORT CALHLOUN NUCLEAR PLANT

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with officials from the Omaha Public Power District in Omaha, Neb., on July 27, to discuss post flooding recovery actions at the Fort Calhoun nuclear plant. OPPD operates the plant, located 19 miles north of Omaha.

The meeting, which is open to public observation, will begin at 9 a.m. at the Doubletree Inn, 1616 Dodge St.

Fort Calhoun is shut down and remains in a safe mode under an Unusual Event declared by the licensee on June 6 because of flooding along the Missouri River.

Conferees will discuss the status of actions being taken to keep the plant safe during flooding at the site and planned post-flooding recovery actions.

Members of the NRC staff will be available to answer questions from the public after the business portion of the meeting.
