NRC RECOGNIZED FOR DIVERSITY/WORK LIFE BALANCE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is one of 100 companies and government agencies recognized for diversity and work/life balance by *Diversity/Careers in Engineering & Information Technology* magazine. This will make the fifth consecutive year the agency has received this recognition.

“At the NRC, we recognize that an organization's reputation for supporting workplace diversity is an important factor in attracting and retaining a high-performing workforce,” said Miriam Cohen, director of Human Resources. “Equally important to the organization’s reputation for hiring and cultivating diverse talent is the emphasis on how diversity continues to make the NRC a better place to work.”

NRC was identified by the magazine’s readers and website visitors for its diversity strengths and as an employer of technical professionals. The survey results strongly recognized a number of NRC’s diversity attributes including: support of minorities and women, attention to work/life balance and commitment to supplier diversity.

Since 2007, the NRC has consecutively captured the top ranking among large federal agencies as one of the *Best Places to Work in the Federal Government* by the Partnership for Public Service and the American University Institute for the Study of Public Policy Implementation.
