## NRC TO DISCUSS JAPAN TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS AUG. 31 IN ROCKVILLE, MD

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with stakeholder representatives and the public on Wednesday, Aug. 31, to discuss the staff's proposal for near-term action on [recommendations](#) from the agency's Japan task force.

The meeting will run from 1-4 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room on the first floor of One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike in Rockville. The staff will propose which of the task force recommendations the Commission should act on without unnecessary delay. The staff will also describe its process for selecting the near-term recommendations, as well as the Commission's process for acting on the proposal. Stakeholder representatives will offer their views on the proposal and the public will also have the opportunity to comment on the recommendations. These comments will be provided to the Commission along with the staff's proposal.
