NRC TO HOLD OPEN HOUSE FOR SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT LICENSE RENEWAL

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold an open house on Aug. 1 in Bay City, Texas, to discuss the results of an inspection for the South Texas Project license renewal application. The plant is operated by the South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Co.

The open house is informal and will be held from 4 to 5:30 p.m. in the Center for Energy Development, 4000 Ave. F, in Bay City.

South Texas Project Units 1 and 2 are both pressurized-water nuclear reactors, located 12 miles southwest of Bay City. The plant's current operating licenses for Units 1 and 2 will expire on Aug. 20, 2027, and Dec. 15, 2028, respectively.
