NRC TO HOLD MEETING WITH NEBRASKA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT ON COOPER NUCLEAR STATION

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold a meeting with officials from the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) on June 26 to discuss the licensee's actions to improve human performance and problem-solving issues at the Cooper nuclear plant. Cooper is located 23 miles south of Nebraska City, Neb.

The meeting, which will be open to public observation, will be held from 8-11 a.m. on Wednesday, June 26, in the NRC's Region IV office, 1600 E. Lamar Blvd, Arlington, Texas.

NPPD officials will brief NRC staff on recent improvement efforts to address human performance and problem solving deficiencies detailed in the NRC's annual assessment letter.
