EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Management Directive (MD) 3.56, "Micrographics Management," has been eliminated. When the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission deployed the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System in 1999, the NRC stopped creating new micrographics materials and ended its micrographics management program. Thus, those portions of MD 3.56 that address the creation of new micrographic materials are no longer needed and are being deleted. Because certain NRC records in micrographic form are still used occasionally, those applicable portions of MD 3.56 that address their use and retention are included in MD 3.53, "NRC Records and Document Management Program"; NUREG-0910, Rev. 4, "NRC Comprehensive Records Disposition Schedule"; or other guidance and procedures.
