10th Annual Fuel Cycle Information Exchange to be Held June 9-10 in Rockville, Md.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will host its 10th annual Fuel Cycle Information Exchange on June 9-10 at the agency's headquarters in Rockville, Md. This event allows NRC staff, licensees, international counterparts, members of the public and other stakeholders to discuss issues related to uranium enrichment and conversion, nuclear fuel fabrication, and the deconversion of depleted uranium tails.

Online [registration](#) will be open until May 31. Onsite registration will also be available during the conference.

NRC Commissioners William Ostendorff and Jeff Baran and Executive Director for Operations Mark Satorius will deliver remarks. Eileen Supko, Principal of Energy Resources International, will give a keynote address the morning of June 9. The conference will include discussions and presentations on safety culture, licensing and inspection, operating experience, and security and safeguards.

The conference will run from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday and 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wednesday in the NRC Auditorium. A telephone bridge line has been set up for those who cannot attend in person. An operator will moderate the bridge line, allowing participants to ask questions at designated times.
