Stakeholder Attendees

The NRC received 12 comments from stakeholders during the webinar:

- Six comments were related to the trustworthiness and reliability (T&R) process. These
 comments were related to adjusting the 10-year reinvestigation periodicity;
 establishment of T&R criteria; reviewing the requirements for undisclosed references;
 clarification on where to submit information on newly approved Reviewing Officials (RO);
 background checks for individuals from foreign countries; and requirement for ROs
 receiving access to Safeguards Information;
- Four comments were related to physical security measures. These comments were
 related to clarification of continuous monitoring and weekly check requirements; physical
 barrier requirements for mobile devices and isolation of radioactive material to prevent
 aggregation; and LLEA notifications that also require notification to the regulatory
 agency;
- Two comments were related to training.
