## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Guidance found in Management Directive (MD) 11.8, "NRC Procedures for Placement and Monitoring of Work with Federal Agencies Other Than U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Laboratory Work," has been combined and updated and may be found in MD 11.7, "NRC Procedures for Placement and Monitoring of Work with Federal Agencies and U.S. Department of Energy Laboratories." Therefore, MD 11.8 is **eliminated**.

MD 11.7 provides staff with criteria and guidance to effectively manage work placed with other Federal agencies, U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) laboratories, as well as the actions necessary to implement the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the NRC and DOE to continue joint activities subsequent to the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974.
