The Commission met with the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) to discuss the Committee’s recent accomplishments and its ongoing and future activities. The ACRS presented updates on the following specific items: 1) Safety Evaluation of License Amendment Request by South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company to Adopt a Risk-Informed Resolution of Generic Safety Issue-191; 2) Consequential Steam Generator Tube Rupture; 3) Safety Evaluation of the NuScale Power, LLC Topical Report TR-0815-16497-P, “Safety Classification of Passive Nuclear Power Plant Electrical Systems,” Revision 1; and 4) Draft Proposed Rulemaking 10 CFR 73.53, “Requirements for Cyber Security at Nuclear Fuel Cycle Facilities,” Related Parts 70, 73, and 40, and Draft Regulatory Guide DG-5062, “Cyber Security Programs for Nuclear Fuel Cycle Facilities.”
