Dear Mr. Chairman:

Section 1097(d)(1) of the "National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018" (Public Law 115-91) (the Act) requires agencies, including the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), in consultation with the Director of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management and the U.S. Office of Special Counsel, to incorporate the protection of whistleblowers into job requirements and performance standards of supervisory employees. Under the Act, each agency must annually submit a report to Congress detailing the number of supervisors who failed to meet these critical standards, the reasons for the determination that they failed, and each performance-based or corrective action taken by the agency in response.

Interagency guidance for the required annual reports is forthcoming. In the interim, the NRC can report that there were no confirmed violations at the agency of the Act's whistleblower provisions since they went into effect.
