On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your January 21, 2020, letter requesting an extension of the public comment period on the Indian Point Energy Center license transfer application.

On January 23, 2020, the NRC published a notification in the *Federal Register* that opened a 30-day public comment period on the license transfer application. The comment period was scheduled to close on February 24, 2020. The NRC staff has agreed with your request to extend the comment period for an additional 30 days, until March 25, 2020. A notice of this extension will be published in the *Federal Register*.
