Enclosed is the Final After Action Review/Improvement Plan (AAR/IP), for the Byron Station Radiological Emergency Preparedness, Partial Participation, Plume Exposure Pathway Exercise conducted on Tuesday, October 29, 2019. There were no Level 1, Level 2, or Plan Issues identified for the State of Illinois or Winnebago County. There were no Level 1 or Plan Issues identified for Ogle County.

There was one Level 2 Finding identified for Ogle County. The Illinois Emergency Management Agency will determine the schedule of corrective actions.

Based on the results of the exercise, the planning and preparedness for the State of Illinois and affected local jurisdictions provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect public health and safety. Therefore, in accordance with Title 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 350, approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Illinois remains in effect.
