SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SEPTEMBER 14, 2020, TELECONFERENCE

REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION STATUS OF

NUREG/BR-0204 REVISION 3 AND ASSOCIATED NRC FORMS

On September 14, 2020, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a Category 2 public teleconference where the NRC staff provided industry representatives, licensees, and vendors a status update regarding the implementation of NUREG/BR-0204, Revision 3, and the associated revisions to NRC Forms 540, 541 and 542.

The teleconference was noticed on the NRC's public Web site on August 31, 2020, and the notice and meeting agenda is available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System at Accession No. ML20244A327.

During this teleconference NRC staff stated that it had received several requests to delay implementation of the revisions to NRC forms 540, 541 and 542 associated with NUREG/BR-0204, "Instructions for Completing NRC's Uniform Low-Level Radioactive Waste Manifest," Revision 3. NRC staff stated that in response to those requests as well as other considerations, the NRC has decided to delay the implementation of NUREG/BR-0204, Revision 3 until further notice and is currently in the process of changing NRC Forms 540, 541 and 542 back to the January 2020 versions, which may take one month to complete. NRC staff noted that in the interim, based on the definitions section of Appendix G to 10 CFR Part 20, licensees need not use originals of the NRC uniform waste manifest forms as long as any substitute forms are equivalent to the original documentation in respect to content, clarity, size, and location of information. NRC staff also noted it would issue a *Federal Register* Notice to this effect. This *Federal Register* Notice is scheduled to publish on September 30, 2020.

No comments from members of industry were offered when NRC staff asked if there would be a burden to industry if NRC delayed implementation of NUREG/BR, Revision 3. NRC staff noted that they wanted to ensure that there were no unintended consequences if the implementation of the revisions to NRC forms 540, 541 and 542 associated with NUREG/BR-0204, Revision 3 was delayed.

Several commenters stated their desire to delay implementation of the forms associated with NUREG/BR-0204, Rev. 3 until March 31, 2021.

The NRC staff did not commit to a specific timeframe for implementation of NUREG/BR-0204 Revision 3 rather they stated they plan to have a meeting to discuss future implementation of NUREG/BR-0204, Revision 3.

No comments from members of the public or state regulators were offered when requested before the end of the meeting.
