On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am transmitting the report for the fourth quarter in Fiscal Year 2020 in response to the revised requirements noted in the September 26, 2019, letter from the Committee on Environment and Public Works and Subcommittee on Clean Air and Nuclear Safety.
