I. SECY-22-0039 – FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT CO. (TURKEY POINT NUCLEAR
GENERATING UNITS 3 AND 4)

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order that provides direction to the parties in this adjudication following the Commission's decision in CLI-22-2. In that decision, the Commission solicited views on the practical effects of two options—leaving in place the subsequently renewed licenses for Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Units 3 and 4, or reinstating the previous licenses. The Memorandum and Order affirms the Commission's direction in CLI-22-2 to shorten the expiration dates of the Turkey Point licenses to 2032 and 2033, and terminates this proceeding.

(Subsequently, on June 3, 2022, the Assistant for Rulemakings and Adjudications signed the Memorandum and Order.)

II. SECY-22-0040 - CONSTELLATION ENERGY GENERATION, LLC (F/K/A EXELON
GENERATION CO., LLC) (PEACH BOTTOM ATOMIC POWER STATION, UNITS 2
AND 3)

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order that provides direction to the participants following the Commission's decision in CLI-22-4. In that decision, the Commission solicited views on the practical effects of two options—leaving in place the subsequently renewed licenses for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Units 2 and 3, or reinstating the previous licenses. Additionally, the Memorandum and Order addresses Constellation's request for reconsideration of the direction to the NRC Staff in CLI-22-4 to amend the expiration dates of the subsequently renewed licenses. The Memorandum and Order denies Constellation's petition for reconsideration, affirms the Commission's direction in CLI-22-4 to shorten the expiration dates of the Peach Bottom licenses to 2033 and 2034, and terminates this proceeding.
