Three.

i. If no, please explain why and provide the timeline expected to complete data center closures.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has one remaining Tiered data center that is not a key mission facility. The NRC plans to continue to reduce operating costs by closing this data center. The NRC continues to migrate systems to the Cloud and our co-location facility. The closure of this data center is scheduled to be completed by the 4th quarter of fiscal year 2026.
