I. <u>SECY-23-0082 – PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC CO., DIABLO CANYON</u> INDEPENDENT SPENT FUEL STORAGE INSTALLATION, APPEAL OF LBP-23-7

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to Pacific Gas and Electric Co.'s (PG&E) appeal of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision in LBP-23-7. In that decision, the Board granted the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace's hearing request and admitted a single contention which challenged PG&E's analysis of financial qualifications. Subsequently, PG&E updated its application, appealed the Board's decision, and requested the Board to dismiss the contention as moot. Mothers for Peace also moved to withdraw the contention. In LBP-23-8, the Board dismissed the contention and terminated the proceeding. The Memorandum and Order affirms that PG&E's appeal has become moot, vacates the Board's decision in LBP-23-7, and dismisses the appeal.
