**Public Meetings on Callaway Plant License Renewal**

On March 19, 2014, the staff held two identical public meetings in Fulton, Missouri, to discuss the preliminary findings of, and receive public comments on, the draft supplemental environmental impact statement (SEIS) on the proposed renewal of the operating license for Callaway Plant, Unit 1 (Callaway). The preliminary finding of this report is that the adverse environmental impacts of license renewal for Callaway are not great enough to deny the option of license renewal for energy-planning decision-makers. Approximately 30 people attended each meeting. The public comment period will close on April 7, 2014. The staff plans to issue the final SEIS by November 2014.
