The Commission was briefed by Norman P. Neureiter, National Academies Study Chair; Senior Adviser, Center for Science Diplomacy, and Acting Director, Center for Science, Technology, and Security Policy of the American Association for the Advancement of Science; and B. John Garrick, National Academies Study Vice-Chair, and Executive Consultant, on the recent report issued by the National Research Council-National Academy of Sciences on lessons-learned from the Fukushima Dai-ichi accident. This was followed by a briefing by an external panel and the NRC staff on the status of actions taken by the NRC and industry in response to lessons-learned from the Fukushima Dai-ichi accident, with a focus on improved capabilities related to station blackout events. The external panel included Jim Scarola, Executive Director – U.S. Industry Fukushima Response, and Co-Chair of the industry's Fukushima Response Steering Committee; Pete Sena, President and Chief Nuclear Officer, FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company; Jean-Christophe Niel, Director General, ASN; Joseph G. Klinger, Assistant Director, Division of Nuclear Safety, Illinois Emergency Management Agency; and David Lochbaum, Director, Nuclear Safety Project, Union of Concerned Scientists

The Commission looks forward to the staff's review of the National Academy report.
